Male Richardson's ground squirrels can emerge as early as mid-February, with females following soon after. *Having a control plan in place before activity begins is key to effective management.*

The Saskatchewan Government website offers helpful information on controlling the Richardson's ground squirrel and outlines available bait options. After months of hibernation, gophers emerge in search of food, making baiting most effective before vegetation turns green and new plant growth becomes their primary food source.

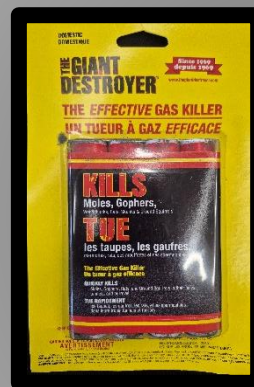
